## NORTH AMERICAN CUP RULES

TEAM REQUIREMENTS: Each division - All teams, shall be made of a minimum six team players. Each team can add two alternates and one coach. Making it a maximum of nine players on a team. Men and Women are allowed to play on a team. Women will use their overall rankings. ALTERNATES: Once an alternate is placed in the line up on the team event form, the alternate must play out the entire match. If an alternate comes in during a match due to replacing a team member due to illness. The alternate must finish the match. The team member that was replaced must sit out the entire match. Alternates are not required to play unless they were listed in the line up at the start of the match.
STATE TEAMS: Team members must meet at least one of these requirements. 1. Team member is a resident or co-resident of that state. 2. Team member works in neighboring state and chooses to play with neighboring state. 3. Team member lives in one state and has no local tournament to attend. Team member only plays is in neighboring state for local events. If two states boarder each other and they do not have enough players in their state they may join together to play with each other to make a state team. Women's Team members may be from their state or region. This years regions will be the national time zones.
FORMING TEAMS: Everyone is welcome to put a team together for their state. If there are two teams or more in the same division from the same state; these teams will have a first round playoff. The winner of the playoff will represent their state in the NAC. All players can only be on one team.
MATCHES: Matches shall be played in this order Doubles, Singles, Doubles, Singles, and Doubles. The first Doubles and Singles matches shall go at the same time. All games except tie breakers shall be to five. All games shall be played no matter the game wins. Total points shall determine the winner of the match. The team with the most points shall advance on the chart. In case of a tie a singles match one game to seven win by two shall be played. A tie breakers name must be written on the match form before the match starts. Tie breaker players cannot have already played a singles set during the match. All matches will start on time. Recall procedure will be strictly enforced. ITSF rules of play apply. IFP points will be used to determine rankings.
EVENT LINEUP FORMS: All event lineup forms must be filled out in full prior to the start of a match. Be sure to write the tie breaker player on to the form before the match starts. The teams are responsible for checking the charts and completing their event form before the start of the next match.
OFFICIALS: If an official is requested, then one member from each team not playing in the match will be responsible for officiating matched together.
TEAM FEES: The fee for each team is $\$ 120.00$ paid by the time registration ends on Friday night.
TEAM REGISTRATION: The captain of each team must sign in July 4, 2014 by 11:00 PM. Saturday at 10:00AM the brackets will be randomly drawn. Every team must then fill out the team lineup for their first match on Sunday and turn it in to the stage by 6:00PM Saturday
WOMEN'S TEAMS: Must register by June 20th. Only a commitment of a team needs to be turned in at this time. The team roster will be due on July 5 , 2014 . OPENING CEREMONY: At 10:00AM Sunday all State Teams shall be lined up in alphabetical order then each team shall be introduced up on the stage during opening ceremonies. Team Captains will introduce each team member by name and ranking. Please wear team uniforms during ceremony and bring state flag.
UNIFORMS: Team jackets and pants are suggested but not required. Team shirts are required. State name must be displayed on the center back of the team shirt.
STATE FLAG: State flags are recommended but not required. For all teams bringing flags, please display your flag during the opening ceremony.
MULTI Team Playoff: If there is more than one team representing a state in the same division, then we will have a single elimination play off to determine the team to represent that state. Only one team in each division can represent a state.
DISPUTES: All disputes shall be submitted to the tournament head official. Tournament Head Official to make final ruling.
